## Allegro House Rockport, Texas

### **Project Description**

Key Allegro, originally a fishing village on the Texas coast, has become the premier waterfront community in Rockport, Texas. The program for the new community center included site assessment of an existing, 1960's facility so dilapidated that the roof caved inward and the walls bowed outward. The new building uses the existing site features including the swimming pool and parking lot. The new building included a large indoor and outdoor hall, office, break room, restrooms and storage. An exposed steel structure, cherry wood ceilings, and polished concrete floors provide a refined, modern material palette that can endure the high demands of the building type. Because of its coastal location, the building conforms to the Texas Windstorm Act. Located within walking distance to the marina, the new community center will host community events, fishing tournaments, dinner parties, weddings and other functions.
